

IBTA TWIRLING EXAMS

From November 30th 2013 we will be holding an optional extra training night to prepare our members to take some twirling exams.

Jo and Nicky have completed these exams themselves and have also recently taken part in a seminar explaining how to teach and judge the exams.

The exams are not compulsory but the members might find that they help with their general twirling ability.

The session will take place on a Friday night in the sports hall at Paignton college, Borough road, 7—8.

This hall is being shared with another sports team so we expect any members that attend to be on their best behaviour with absolutely no messing around or back chatting. If this happens you will be asked to leave the session.

The cost of this is only £1 to be paid on the night, any Fridays that we do not use the hall we still have to pay for, so it is open to any of you that wish to do some extra training, along with if you do not wish to take exams but want to use the extra time to practice, you can.

If your child/children do not want to take exams now but wish to in the future this is fine, they can start at any time.

For those members wishing to teach twirling, you have to have completed up to and including your Silver level twirling exam and be of 16 years old.

The Twirling Exams are as follows: Pre-Bronze, Bronze, Pre-Silver, Silver, Pre-Gold, Gold, Diamond, Platinum

You will receive a certificate and medal When completed.
